BOARD MEMBERS’ REMUNERATION & TRAVEL AND SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCES

Board Members’ Remuneration and Expenses

The Chairman and Board members receive remuneration and expenses. The Board members are appointed for a fixed term of 3 years. In 2010/11 the Board members received remuneration of £5,050 per annum paid at a monthly rate of £ 420.83. Travel and Subsistence

The Chairman and Board members’ travel and subsistence allowances are in line with DOE Local Government (LG) arrangements. Currently Circulars [LG16/06](#) and [LG 10/09](#). See extract below;
