### Request

Is the Restorative Practice Strategy document the same as the Restorative Interventions Strategy document which I have seen referenced in other PBNI material and originally requested. I would like a complete list of all PBNI strategy, policy, procedure and guidance documents currently in use.

### Response

In respect of your initial query, I should have made it clearer in my previous response (reference 023.20.14) that we do not hold a Restorative Intervention Strategy 2014-2017 document - only the Restorative Practice Strategy 2014-2017 document which I sent to you. You may have seen a reference in other documents to a PBNI objective to have a restorative interventions strategy, but the document I sent you was the actual Strategy approved by the Board.

Please find attached a list of all current PBNI approved strategy, policy, procedure and/or guidance documents.

You have suggested that your current request is to help your understanding. If there is a specific area of PBNI business which is of interest to you or if you have a particular focus, it may be helpful, as indicated in a previous response, for you to speak to the relevant manager with responsibility for that area, to aid your understanding?
